Starting on January 1, 2025, BlueCross BlueShield of Oklahoma will provide your Helmerich & Payne prescription benefits through our pharmacy benefit manager Prime Therapeutics® (Prime). If you plan to continue your medical coverage, this letter covers some key features of your new pharmacy benefit, how to fill your prescriptions and more.

If there are changes with your new benefits that will affect you, you may get a separate letter. That letter will tell you how the changes apply to you and what you should do next.

You should receive a new ID card prior to January 1, 2025. Please show your Member ID card to both your pharmacy and medical providers. Note: you will have one ID card for both medical and pharmacy.

YOUR DRUG LIST – WHAT PRESCRIPTION DRUGS ARE COVERED

Your new **Balanced** Drug List covers many of the same prescription drugs as your current plan. You can check to see if the drugs you are taking will be covered at bcbsok.com/docs/rx-drugs/drug-lists/ok/rx-list-bal-ok-2025.pdf.

FILLING YOUR PRESCRIPTIONS

Starting January 1, 2025, you can find a pharmacy in the Traditional Select Network by logging in to your member online account. Please note, changes could be made to the pharmacies in the future.

You may visit **MyPrime.com** to find an in-network **90-day supply** retail pharmacy near you or Express Scripts home delivery service to fill your covered, maintenance prescriptions.

To start using the home delivery pharmacy service after January 1, 2025, visit express-scripts.com/rx. Click on “Register Now” or “Get Started” to create an account using your Member ID and follow the steps, or you can call (833) 715-0942. Your doctor can send a new prescription electronically to EXPRESS SCRIPTS HOME DELIVERY, or by phone or fax.

Specialty medications: Prescriptions that are approved for self-administration (like oral capsules or injections you can give yourself) *must* be filled through an in-network specialty pharmacy to avoid paying higher out-of-pocket costs.

Please Note: Specialty medicines that must be given to you by a health care professional may be covered under your medical plan benefits. See your medical plan materials for details.

NO-COST PREVENTIVE BENEFITS

Your new pharmacy benefits may cover some prescription and over-the-counter preventive medicines at little or no cost to you, even if you haven’t met your deductible or out-of-pocket maximum. This benefit only applies when you use in-network pharmacies and doctors.

UTILIZATION MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS

Your plan has programs to help make sure medicines are used safely and appropriately. These include **prior authorization, step therapy and dispensing limits**. Your medicine(s) may need to be reviewed under these programs before being covered, even if you have participated in similar programs in the past.

GETTING STARTED WITH DIGITAL TOOLS

Before January 1, 2025, you can visit the Prime member website, MyPrime.com, to check coverage of your drugs, get prescription drug cost estimates and search for network pharmacies near you. On MyPrime.com, click “explore MyPrime” and follow the prompts in the drop-down menu. Be sure to answer “No” for Medicare Part D when selecting your plan. Choose **Traditional Select Network** and **Balanced Drug List**.

After January 1, 2025, you can view your specific prescription drug plan benefit information by registering or logging in to your Blue Access for MembersSM account from bcbsok.com Once in BAMSM, you can click on “Pharmacy” or link to your own account on MyPrime.com.
